The World Summit of the Committees of the Future 12-13 October 2022

The World Summit of the Committees of the Future brings together, for the first time, the committees responsible for dealing with future issues in different parliaments. The World Summit will be held in the Parliament of Finland on 12-13 October 2022 (Little Parliament building).

Topics of the World Summit

The goal of the World Summit is to introduce the future committees of different countries to each other and to identify topics that the committees want to discuss together. In their speeches, the committees of the various parliaments will highlight themes they consider important. They include, for example, the possibilities of technology in achieving more environmentally friendly and equal development, the need for transnational regulation of digital business and the use of algorithms, and the importance of parliamentary cooperation in proactive decision-making and responding to sustainability challenges.











2. How would you describe the level of awareness and literacy in the "use of the future" to inform present decision-making and orient action among parliamentarians in your country?
















5. Are parliamentary staff and members of your Parliament familiar with the concepts of "anticipatory governance" and "responsible anticipation"











FINAL DECLARATION

The Second World Summit of Futures Commissions, held in Montevideo, Uruguay, brought together parliamentarians and representatives from 70 countries, and was organized by the Parliament of Uruguay and the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU).

Summary of the Declaration of the Second World Summit of Futures Committees in Parliaments 2023

I-CONTEXT

- We are at a historic inflection point due to technological advancements, especially in AI, which present both opportunities and challenges for democracies and societies at large.
- > Anticipatory governance and regulatory approaches need to be re-examined in the face of the evolving nature of AI.
- > The **need for international cooperation is emphasized**, taking into account both the different levels of development in Al between countries, as well as the global condition of its scope.
- Large tech platforms have a significant responsibility, especially when it comes to transparency and collaboration with the public sector.

II- COMMITMENT TO DEMOCRACY IN THE AGE OF AI:

- All poses challenges to democratic institutions, such as **issues of surveillance**, **privacy**, **the threat of deepfakes**, increasing gaps and biases. An approach that balances innovation with human rights and **ethical principles is essential**.
- The inadequacy of conventional reactive mechanisms in the face of the speed and risks of AI is highlighted.
- A shift towards an anticipatory paradigm is proposed, with an emphasis on "responsible anticipation", considering a long-term vision and a deep understanding of the evolutionary nature of AI in dynamics of complexity and uncertainty.



III- INTEGRATING ANTICIPATORY CAPACITIES AND COMPETENCIES IN PARLIAMENTS:

- ➤ It highlights the need for Parliaments to incorporate capacities and anticipatory practices to manage into the accelerated, profound and intertwined changes that require other frames competencies and methods for deliberation, knowledge generation, decision-making and action.
- > Futures Committees are seen as pivotal spaces and instruments to anticipate, understand and respond in an agile and better-informed way to emerging challenges.
- The need for a paradigm shift to face the current challenges is emphasized and the role of the Futures Commisttees in this regard is highlighted.
- > The importance of literate skills in both the 'use of the future' and AI at the wider societal level is underlined.

IV- CONSIDERATIONS ON ACTUAL AI REGULATIONS AND THE WAY FORWARD:

- > It calls for ethical, human-centered regulation, on principles of transparency, anticipatory accountability, fairness, privacy and data law, security, public participation, education, interdisciplinary collaboration, robustness, beneficial objectives, continuous monitoring, and global cooperation.
- It highlights the importance of global standards for the regulation of AI and the need to follow its evolution dynamics in advance (AGI).
- > It highlights the need for a human rights-based perspective and the inclusion of gender and future generations.

V- STRENGTHENING INTER-PARLIAMENTARY COLLABORATIONS:

- The need for cooperation between Parliaments and Futures Committees at the global level is emphasized.
- > The creation of an Interactive World Map to share parliamentary actions related to AI and cooperation through a Global Network of Futures Committees in Parliaments is proposed

VI - APPEAL TO THE UNITED NATIONS:

- > The UN is called upon to highlight the role of parliaments in global anticipatory governance.
- It proposes the creation of a **global framework for the governance of the evolving AI** with a focus on protecting human rights and harnessing AI for global good with an active role for Parliaments and the IPU.

VII - NEXT STEPS:

- It is proposed to continue with the initiatives of the Futures Committees and to hold annual meetings.
- It concludes by **highlighting the importance of anticipatory capabilities and competencies and global collaboration** to address current and future challenges related to AI (and AGI in particular).
- The declaration reaffirms the commitment of Parliaments to work together to ensure that AI serves humanity and develops ethically, equitably and in harmony with democratic values and human rights.






