





## State of the Future and AI




Upon release of the State of the Future, CIFS sent out the publication along with an explanation about its use and pointing to several highlights.

## Aeon & Mewtronix

Aeon & Mewtronix is a comic book made in collaboration between CIFS, UNESCO and Teach The Future. It's now the most translated material in the Teach the Future library with 10 different languages - including Dutch, Farsi, Filipino and more. With the latest additions, we now potentially reach 150–200 million children (10–12 years) globally. And more languages are on the way (Greek, Urdu and Turkish).

The number of translations isn't necessarily what matters, of course - it's all about how, and whether, the material is actually used. Last month, our partners in Colombia, who did the Spanish translation, shared that it had been downloaded 3000 times since they posted it on their webpage before the summer.

Even more heartwarming: our partner in Iran, who translated it into Farsi together with his 14-year-old daughter in his spare time, hosted a launch-teaching session last week at a local school in Tehran to introduce Aeon & Mewtronix.

We are very proud of this publication that is bringing hope and futures to school children all over the world.

## FutuResilience


The FUTURESILIENCE is a EU Horizon. It project aims to strengthen European economic and social resilience through an enhanced ability to adapt and quickly respond to future crises.

The project facilitate the fast and effective use of policy relevant research and innovation (R&I) findings through 10 pilot cases called 'Future Resilience Labs'. During the experimentation, multiple stakeholders have discussed and tested evidence-based strategies tailored to their specific context and matching their local needs, in a co-creation environment and applying Foresight and participative methodologies.



## Danish Coalition for Future Generations (Fremtidskoalitionen)

CIFS is engaged with and a key partner in The Future Coalition is a gathering point for actors in Denmark across sectors who work together to promote well-being for future generations.

The goal is to support an ambitious political implementation of the UN's "Declaration for Future Generations", to which Denmark has committed.

The coalition aims to create knowledge and a common language about the future to ensure broad popular support, independent of party politics.

The Future Coalition will work to ensure that Denmark is a role model for the global movement for the well-being of future generations. To do this, the Future Coalition is working to ensure that the Danish Parliament implements:

- Binding legislation to ensure that all initiatives with long-term effects are designed so that they do not compromise the well-being of future generations.
- Independent enforcement in the form of a new institution to be established at arm's length from the government in power at any given time, and a strong mandate to enforce that legislation for the well-being of future generations is implemented in full compliance with UN recommendations.
- Ethical representation of future generations, which is thus represented on the basis of a "hypothetical acceptance criterion", i.e. that the representation must reasonably be expected to be acceptable to the future generations themselves.

## Soon - Laboratory for Possible Futures

CIFS has developed the Soon lab. Soon is part of a larger effort in Denmark, which signed the UN's "Declaration for Future Generations" in September 2024.

Soon is an experimental space in Copenhagen, Denmark, that works to help people and organizations shape the future by combining futures research, social innovation, and artistic methods. It opened on March 14, 2025, at Thoravej 29 and aims to strengthen the imagination and ability to act for future generations. The lab collaborates with various partners on projects, including a "Futures Fellows" program, and works on issues related to intergenerational fairness and sustainable futures.

Purpose: To connect futures research, social innovation, and artistic methods to address complex challenges and create a desired future.

Opening Date: March 14, 2025.
