



Launch of FEN Exchanges – Monthly Thematic Meetings 2025/2026

Following the meeting in September and the many encouraging messages received about the value of network exchange and the desire to expand it, we launched a new monthly thematic meetings: **FEN Exchanges**.

These sessions will take place **every second Thursday of the month at 4:00 p.m. (CET)** and will last for one hour. These were the most mentioned themes by the members:
