The Futures Studio

An experiential futures course by **Stuart Candy** and **Jonathon Keats**—developed in collaboration with Futures Design Lab—is a unique opportunity to explore and prototype possible futures in a hands-on way. Candy, as Faculty of Excellence, brings his pioneering experiential futures approach, while Keats contributes his speculative artistic practice, creating a learning experience that blends rigor, creativity, and strategic imagination.

An immersive exercise led by futurist Stuart Candy, where students explored scenarios for 2050. As part of the national Futures Design Lab initiative, it showcases how we use strategic foresight and experiential methods to help communities imagine and shape desirable futures.




International Book Fairs
